### **Rick's Custom Fencing & Decking Helps Children in Need**

**Hillsboro, OR** - Rick's Custom Fencing & Decking is not only known for providing high quality products and customer service, but also for being extremely community oriented, which is why they have recently made three donations to three local children's foundations. These three foundations include CASA for Children, [The Arc Family Center](#), and the Muscular Dystrophy Association.

Rick's was contacted by CASA for Children regarding their annual auction to raise funds for their organization. CASA for Children advocates for the best interests of children who have been abused or neglected and are under the protection of the Juvenile Courts in Multnomah and Washington Counties in Oregon. Their purpose is to secure a safe and permanent family for each child as quickly as possible. The money raised from Rick's donation will help out in their efforts to recruit, train and support citizen volunteers who serve as Court Appointed Special Advocates, or CASA Volunteers.

[Rick's Custom Fencing & Decking has also donated fencing materials to the Arc Family Center located in Vancouver, Washington. The center is building a new playground that is specially designed for kids under the age of three with disabilities. This special outdoor classroom brings children and families together to master the skills of success through play and achievement. The last organization that Rick's has donated to is the Muscular Dystrophy Association, where a young boy from Northeast Portland is fighting an extremely rare muscular dystrophy called Peripheral Neuropathy. This disease caused the 11-year-old boy to have absolute dependency on a motorized scooter or wheelchair. The family's home does not have a ramp due to their limited income. As a result, Rick's Fencing has decided to donate the materials needed to construct a ramp that is suitable for the scooter.
