


















Installation Hints

Staining and finishing: A penetrating semi-transparent stain which contains ultraviolet blockers provides the greatest level of protection from the elements. Rick's Custom Fecning & Decking has developed one of the best stains on the market with UV protectant and mildew resistance. Ask your sales representatives for details. Although each manufacturer of stain provides careful guidance for their particular products, some basic rules generally hold true.

When applying the stain, we advise the stain be put on as thin layer, and any excess stain be wiped off to avoid excessive product application.

- 1. After installation, perform a water test to see if deck is ready to accept stain—check with your sales representative for details.
- 2. Clean deck thoroughly prior to staining.
- 3. Apply when surface of deck is between 40 and 80 degrees.
- 4. Follow directions of stain manufacturer.
